

# Attendance & Tardy Policy

Attendance is the most important reason for student success in the classroom. The school district's attendance policy will be followed.



- Federal, state, and WCSD defines chronic absenteeism as absences where make-up work (assignments, quizzes, tests, etc.) is not completed.
- Entering the classroom <u>after the bell</u> is considered a **tardy**, or unexcused missed instruction (**UMI**). Tardy **detentions** will be assigned during lunch or after school.
- Excessive tardies that are not excused (EMI) will result in an office referral.

## **Conduct & Behavior Policy**

Be prepared for class (textbook, notebook, assignments, pencils or pens, notebook paper).

- Notebooks must be **organized** with labeled section dividers (Warm-Ups, Notes, Homework, Other).
- Please take care of and keep track of assigned **textbooks**.
- **Homework** must include HW #, assignment, problems written out, and necessary work shown.

Make-up work must be turned in within "time equal to the number of days you were out" of class. If you were absent on the day a **test** was given, you will be expected to make it up the day you return to class. A missed quiz will be grade exempt if the absence is excused. Otherwise, it will be counted as a zero.

### **Help & Support**

If you start falling behind, feel unclear about concepts taught, or were absent, then you must make an effort to <u>catch up!</u> Get **help** as soon as possible!



## **Grading System**

**Academic grades** are <u>weighted</u> based on the following chart:



Academic Grading Scale (per semester)

Α	≥ 90.0%
В	≥ 80.0%
С	≥ 70.0%
D	≥ 60.0%
F	< 60.0%

**Citizenship grades** are based on a student's <u>attitude</u>, conduct, and behavior.

An unexcused missed instruction (**UMI**) will **lower** your citizenship grade by a grade point after the first tardy (per semester).



<u>Missing assignments</u> (**MI**) and assignments you were <u>absent</u> (**AB**) for can be made up for FULL points! Assignments with <u>Zeros</u> (**0**) can be made up to 60% of the points! **Note**: Points will be given only to homework that is <u>fully done</u> with work shown! <u>Chapter test retakes</u> have a maximum score of 80%.

Each student will be given one **hall pass card** per semester. Students must have their **school ID** to use the hall pass for "taking care of business" (i.e. bathroom, water fountain, or locker). Each hall pass card contains 60 minutes of time in blocks of 5. Please limit each trip to 10 minutes. Any time left over from each semester can be turned in for **extra credit** (to be determined). An <u>unexcused missed instruction</u> (UMI) (a.k.a. tardy) will result in the loss of block time. Hall passes are **transferable** for regular use.
